#### Next Meeting – Tuesday 26th April 2011 (7.30pm start)

As you would have noted from the front page, we now have an earlier start time to our meetings. The hall will now be opened around 7.00pm, so the tables and chairs can be set up - and the display plants benched and (hopefully) placed in the correct classes. The main meeting will now start at 7.30pm, with us aiming to finish no later than 10.00pm. (We must vacate the premises by 10.15pm in any case.)

I will be showing a PowerPoint Presentation of from Fred Clarke from Sunset Valley Orchids in California USA on Compact Cattleya Breeding. Fred kindly gave me a copy of his full presentation last year for members of PDOS to see. This is a very impressive programme, with some wonderful photographs of the very latest hybrids, which are really eyecatching.

At the 24th May 2011 meeting I will be showing Fred Clarke's outstanding Catasetum (and allied genera) presentation.

#### **Benching Classes at Meetings**

Most of the plants exhibited at our meetings are placed in the correct classes. Many are fairly obvious, whilst others can sometimes be confusing. If unsure, see me or any of the committee members who should be able to point you in the right direction. The area where most uncertainty exists seems to be the species and miscellaneous classes, as well as the Australian native sections. I aim to do a quick check 5 or so minutes before the meeting starts, so all is ready for the judges.

Please also ensure that all details (Plant name, class number, owners name) are completed on the benching slips, so to make it easier when collating the results that go towards our annual point-score competition.

#### **Last Meeting**

DAVID BUTLER of GREEN VISTA ORCHIDS was our guest speaker and he shared with us his vast experiences and successes with growing and breeding our own native Sarcochilus orchids. His presentation was outstanding, showing some wonderful flowers. David is Australia's (and then probably the worlds!) premier hybridiser of Sarcochilus. His toothpick has produced a lot of champion and awarded plants, mostly for other growers that have purchased flasks direct of bought seedlings from suppliers such as Tinonee Orchids (Ray Clement) or the Australian Orchid Nursery (Wayne Turville).
